We had an unfavorable situation that was due to a number of one-time expenses like: Good Friday offering distributions, taxes, workman comp payment, and VBS expenses.


As of June 30, 2012, we are estimating \$10,845.00 cash on hand. All bills through June have been paid. This means we are heading into the next budget year with a small surplus.

Voter's Meeting - Outcome

On June 24, 2012, the Voter's of Zion approved the 2012/2013 fiscal budget that included:

- Overall budget increased from last budget by 10%
- Average salary increases of 2% for church and school staff
- Support for Camp Pioneer ministry and outreach programs
- Increase support for Sunday School and Vacation Bible School
- Two capital projects sanctuary sound system upgrade & storage unit
- Support for youth ministry programs
- Increase in school tuition and number of students
- Additional teacher salary for a new "3 year olds" class



Budget for the New Year

We were pleased to present another break-even budget (\$442,029 expense equal \$44,029 revenue), but we were especially pleased to announce for the fourth year that we had no carry-over expenses from the previous budget year and that the school continues to be self-funded. This was accomplished throughout the year with increased Church, Mission & Synod (CMS) giving, special gifts and strong expense control.

The new Kingdom fund will receive 80% of the previously budgeted dollars from the retired mortgage. This fund will promote and enhance the Kingdom of God through charitable giving, Christian education (adult and youth), missions, community outreach, etc. The other 20% will be transferred to the Trustee fund to support the maintenance on the church and school facilities.

The retirement of the mortgage is a great opportunity for Zion to use and share our financial gifts. May God guide us in using these gifts and our talents to spread the Good News!

Just a reminder, as we enter into summer vacations we tend to see giving decrease, so we encourage you to remember Zion while you are away on vacation, since our expenses don't go on vacation. Please continue to pray for Zion that we are able to end this new budget year with a positive cash flow.


