What is Camp Cilca?

Camp Cilca is Lutheran (Missouri Synod) camp located smack dab in the middle of Illinois. They have asked for our help this summer to improve their facilities and help with a special needs camp. We'd be foolish to turn an invitation like that down!

Who can go?

Anyone who has a heart for serving who wants to grow in their faith in Christ. Middle-school and younger should bring an adult with them. High school and older (even MUCH older) are welcome! All may bring friends, family, Facebook friends, and other human beings.

What's the cost?

We are going to charge \$200 to cover expenses at the camp, a night in a hotel and a day pass to Cedar Point. Part of that figure will help subsidize fuel costs for those who are generous enough to drive. You'll need to have money on hand for our time in Chicago and a day at Cedar Point (including food). Even at \$200, the church is kicking in some support for you to go on the SUMMIT. (Thank you, Zion!)

I want to go. What now?

Get your hands on \$200. Then invite your friends. Get their hands on \$200. We'll have forms you can fill out indicating you are interested in going (no commitment at this point). We'll have a couple of information meetings in spring to let you know the details of the trip.

I'm not sure I want to go, but I've read this far... so...

If you've never been on a "Mission Trip" before, you are missing out on one of the most amazing things the "church" has to offer. Spending time outside of your comfort zone with other Christians, serving Christ and growing in your faith while developing friendships that will last a very long time is something every Christian should experience. If you've read this far, you should go.

Am I too young?

No. But if you're not yet in High School, you should bring an adult with you. We're going to be 400 miles away from home doing things you've never done before. We'd love to have you on the SUMMIT, but it'll be better for you to have an adult in the background who's there for you.

Am I too old?

No. Sometimes the people who enjoy these kinds of trips the most, who can appreciate what is being done more than others, are people with the most life-experience. No matter what your physical abilities are, we can use you on this trip to make a difference in the lives of people in Jesus' name.
